

# Wood Badge at the Summit / Personal Equipment List

## Required

- Official Scout uniform for your current Scouting position (see Note 1 below)
- Scout activity uniforms (see Note 2 below)
- Quick-dry clothing for River Experience (swimsuit or wicking t-shirt/shorts, water shoes are ideal)
- Shoes or boots (not white, please)
- Windbreaker, sweatshirt or jacket
- Rain gear (poncho or rain suit)
- Underwear
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent
- Sleeping bag\*
- Flashlight with spare batteries and bulb\*
- Pocket knife or multi-tool knife (no fixed-blade knives)
- Medication in labeled containers
- Toiletries
- Towels and washcloths\*
- Pens, pencils, pocket notebook
- Backpack or duffel bag for carrying your gear to the Outdoor Experience area\*

**Note 1:** A complete uniform includes the official shirt; shorts or long pants, socks; and belt. A neckerchief and slide will be provided. If you need to purchase a uniform, please visit your local Scout shop, or ScoutShop.org online at <https://www.scoutshop.org/uniforms-apparel/uniforms.html>

**Note 2:** An activity uniform, sometimes referred to as a Class B, includes a Scout t-shirt or knit shirt and Scout shorts, long pants, skirts, or culottes. We will be in the activity uniform for a majority of the week. You will be provided three shirts which are designed to be used on course, but it is recommended that each participant also bring at least four additional t-shirts or knit shirts. These shirts can be either blank or feature some Scouting element.
